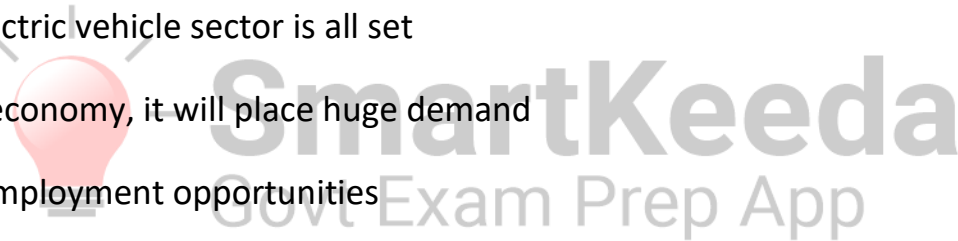

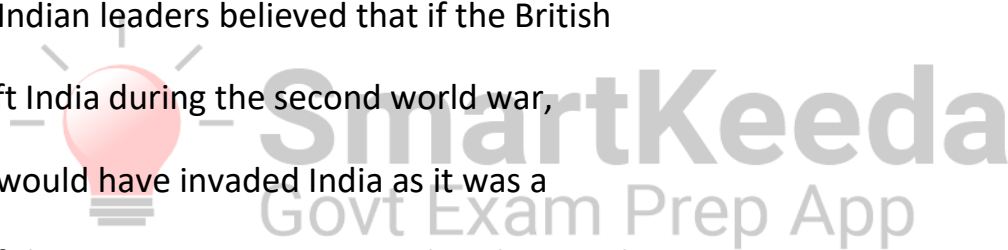

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## Explanation:

1. Fragment D of the sentence is erroneous as it lacks parallelism.

We need to insert 'those' right before the phrase 'with valid passes' to make the sentence grammatically correct and logical.

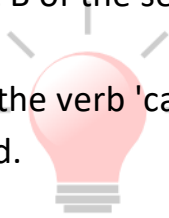
### Correct Sentence:

For one week, the Delhi government is sealing the borders of Delhi for everyone except those providing essential services and **those** with valid passes.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

2. Fragment B of the sentence is erroneous.

Usage of the verb 'carried' is meaningless here. Instead of it, 'carried out' should have been used.



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**Carry (Verb):** To support and move (someone or something) from one place to another.

**Carry out (Phrasal Verb):** To do a particular piece of work, research etc.

**Ex.** The building work was carried out by a local contractor.

### Correct Sentence:

The government's Periodic Labour Force Survey **carried out** in 2017-18 revealed that unemployment in the country reached an all-time high rate of 6.1%.

Option B is hence the correct answer.

3. The error is in part C of the sentence.

Usage of the preposition 'into' right before the noun 'Assembly' is not grammatical. Instead of 'into' 'in' should have been used here.

**Correct sentence:**

Andhra Pradesh is the latest State to favour the alteration of the status quo regarding the Upper House, **in** an Assembly resolution for its Legislative Council's abolition.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

4. Fragment C of the sentence is erroneous.

Here, in place of 'on' there should be 'for' because as the sentence suggests that in the process to boost the economy, the demand 'for' jobs will be 'on' electric vehicle sector not 'on' jobs.

We use-

on- when talking about time, location or dependence.

for- when talking about a purpose or a reason for something.

**Correct Sentence:**

As the electric vehicle sector is all set to boost economy, it will place huge demand for new employment opportunities with the new policy being implemented.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

5. Fragment C of the sentence is erroneous.

Here, the usage of 'same' is grammatically incorrect and we need to change it with 'such'. This is because the sentence is not referring anything to anything instead it is stating some examples.

same as - someone or something that is exactly like (another person or thing being discussed or referred to)

such as - it is phrase used to refer to examples.

**Correct Sentence:**

Agriculture Infrastructure Fund will catalyse creation of post-harvest infrastructure farming assets such as collection centers, cold storages and processing units.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

6. Fragment D of the sentence is erroneous.

Here, the usage of 'throughout' is contextually incorrect and we need to replace it with 'through'. This is because we cannot say that the call was made only during the movement but we can surely say that the call was made in light of the movement ,i.e., the movement inspired Gandhiji to make such a call.

throughout - from beginning to end of (an event or period of time).

through - by means of (a process or intermediate stage).

**Correct Sentence:**

The Quit India Movement, which was also called August Kranti, was launched after the Cripps mission failed wherein Gandhiji made a Do or Die call through the movement.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

7. There is no error.

Option E is hence the correct answer.

8. Fragment C of the sentence is erroneous.

Here, the usage of 'were' is incorrect and it need to be replaced with 'was' in order to make it correct grammatically. This is because the expression *the number* is followed by a singular verb while the expression *a number* is followed by a plural verb.

**Examples:**

*The number of people we need to hire **is** thirteen.*

*A number of people **have** written in about this subject.*

**Correct Sentence:**

The recently released Envistats India 2020 report says that the highest number of heatwave days was recorded in Rajasthan followed by Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand in 2019.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

9. Fragment B of the sentence is erroneous.

Here, the usage of 'accord' is grammatically incorrect and to make it correct, it should be replaced with 'accorded'. This is because we need a verb not a noun.

Accord - (noun) an official agreement or treaty.

Accorded - (verb) give or grant someone (power, status, or recognition).

**Correct Sentence:**

Article 9 of the Sri Lankan Constitution says that Buddhism is accorded the foremost place in the country and it is its duty to protect the religion.

Option B is hence the correct answer.

10. Fragment B of the sentence is erroneous.

Here, the usage of 'of' just after 'million' is unnecessary and it makes it grammatically incorrect. So, to make the sentence correct, we need to remove it from the sentence. This is because-

We say, *6.6 million Syrian refugees or 26 million refugees not 6.6 million **of** Syrian refugees or 26 million **of** refugees.*

**Correct Sentence:**

Bangladesh is facing challenges in providing shelter to over a million Rohingya refugees fleeing persecution from their own country, Myanmar.

Option B is hence the correct answer.



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
