B-F:

These two can also be connected together in order to form a meaningful and grammatically correct sentence.

The complete statement would be:

It is estimated that the monsoon this year will be a bit later than the usual due to the late onset of the monsoon winds in Kerala.

C-D:

These two are also meant to be combined together so that there is a meaningful and grammatically correct sentence.

The complete sentence would be:

There is nothing wrong in making an assumption that the social networking sites are actually harmful for children.

This makes Option D the correct choice among the given options.

2. None of the given pairs can be connected together to form a meaningful and grammatically correct statement.

3. A-E:

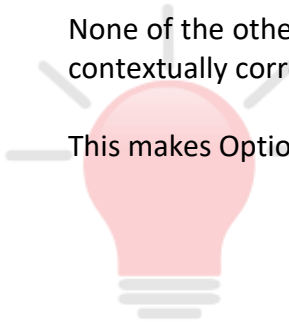
